### **2009 ROAD PROJECT**

The 2009 Rehabilitation Road Contract is underway. We are rehabilitating 22 streets in Delhi Township. The Contractor Prus Construction will be removing (milling) the existing asphalt overlay, making major and minor repairs to the roadway, repairing or replacing curbs, adjusting utilities and resurfacing the roadway. The contract cost of \$1,565,153.25 will be paid through voted road levy tax funds, two grants equaling \$661,500.00 from the Ohio Public Works Commission, a grant for \$140,000.00 from the Community Development Block Grant Program and a grant from the County Engineers License Tax Funds of \$13,500.00. The work will take approximately 120 days with an estimated completion date of October 9, 2009. When completed, the township will have 22 improved roadways which will add to the value of homes.
