

The January 23, 2006 budget hearing of the Delhi Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by the President of the Board Jerome F. Luebbers. Trustee Michael D. Davis, Trustee Albert C. Duebber, Fiscal Officer Kenneth J. Ryan, Acting Administrator Gerard G. Schroeder, Law Director David C. Lane and Financial Advisory Board members, Dale Weisker, Cheryl Sieve, Rose Stertz, Ed Cappel and Mark Forrester were present. The Board received certification from the Fiscal Officer that the rules adopted pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code had been complied with for the meeting.

The hearing began with a review of the Public Works budget. A summary of the budget was presented which included a recommendation to add two positions: a Facilities Technician, and, a Construction Foreman who will be replacing a Service Worker II person who will be retiring on May 1, 2006.

Discussion took place concerning the Facilities Technician position as to what would be the best viable option, either hiring a full-time person, two part-time people, or, going back to contracting with an outside firm as we did in the past with Viox; and, if replacing the Service Worker II person with a Construction Foreman could be justified. No decision was made.

Questions concerning other budgetary line items were addressed with no objections being raised.

There being no further business to come before the Board on Motion of Trustee Duebber and seconded by Trustee Davis the meeting was adjourned. Trustees Luebbers, Davis, and Duebber voted AYE. Motion carried.
