

The February 06, 2006 budget hearing of the Delhi Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by the President of the Board Jerome F. Luebbers. Trustee Michael D. Davis, Trustee Albert C. Duebber, Fiscal Officer Kenneth J. Ryan, Acting Administrator Gerard G. Schroeder, Law Director David C. Lane and Financial Advisory Board members, Dale Weisker, Cheryl Sieve, Rose Stertz, Ed Cappel and Mark Forrester were present. The Board received certification from the Fiscal Officer that the rules adopted pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code had been complied with for the meeting.

The hearing began with a review of the Parks & Recreation budget. There were two outstanding issues concerning facilities improvements: gravel replacement to the trails at Story Woods and replacement of two water fountains within the Parks, would the projects qualify for TIF, and, was there a golf cart stored in Fire Station #30 that could be given to the Parks Department.

The hearing continued with the Police budget review. There were no outstanding issues.

There being no further business to come before the Board on Motion of Trustee Duebber and seconded by Trustee Davis the meeting was adjourned. Trustees Luebbers, Davis, and Duebber voted AYE. Motion carried.
