Delhi Parks Summer Programs

Delhi Township Parks and Recreation Department is proud to offer their 2006 Summer Programs, sponsored by **Cheviot Savings Bank**, from June 5th through August 4th. Various programs will be held throughout the summer beginning with several safety sessions hosted by the Delhi Fire Department and the Delhi Police Department including Baby Sitting/CPR, Bicycle Safety, Fire Safety and Strangers and Dangers with Officer Joe.

New this year will be the Story of Delhi Week. Children participating in this program will hear of historical events and make crafts with the Delhi Historical Society, view and learn about plantings at the Floral Paradise Gardens, and spend three days of adventure at Story Woods Park. The Hamilton County Park District Naturalist will also make an appearance along with their Birds of Prey.

Programs offered again this year include soccer, tennis, basketball, sand volleyball, arts and crafts, wiffle ball, flag football, karate and dance. The **Cincinnati Martial Arts Club** will facilitate the Karate program with a high energy week, while the **Miracle Dance Studio** will teach a variety of dance forms including ballet, tap, jazz, hip-hop and musical theatre. The summer programs conclude with a week of team building and an additional day of the **Skyhawks Sports Academy**.

The cost of participation for most programs is \$7.50 per child per program and participation in each program is limited to Delhi Township residents.
