### Seton Saints to Play Home Games at Delhi Township Park

The Seton Saints and Delhi Township Trustees are joining together to bring high school fast pitch softball to Delhi Township beginning next spring.

Seton will begin using Cheviot Savings Bank Field in Delhi Park as both their practice facility and their home field starting with the 2007 season. For the Saints it marks the first time that they will have a home field with traditional amenities such as outfield fences, field dimensions matched to their sport and a scoreboard. For the Township it provides the opportunity to expand the park's usage as Seton will practice and play their games in the late afternoon when the field would otherwise be unoccupied.

Seton head coach Mary Agricola and assistant coach Bill Mathews shared in the excitement of this announcement.

Agricola said "I see additional opportunities beyond those of having the field for practice and games. The proximity of other fields within Delhi Park opens up the possibility of Seton hosting their own tournament as well as some summer league games including teams with players from other area schools such as Oak Hills, Mercy, St. Ursula and Seton to name a few. Players have been participating in this type of league for about eight years now and it would be nice to have all the games at the same location which hopefully can be worked out."
