For Immediate Release Clean-Up Delhi Day – April 28, 2007

Delhi Township residents are encouraged to participate in the annual “Clean-Up Delhi Day” to be held on Saturday, April 28 from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. in the parking lot of C. O. Harrison School at 585 Neeb Road. This event will take place “rain or shine” and is open to Delhi Township residents only. Proof of residency will be required when items are dropped off. Residents must be in line by 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 28th in order to participate in this free event.

No yard waste, computer equipment, hazardous chemicals, liquids, batteries or closed drums will be accepted.

Furniture, garbage, whiteware products (washing machines, dryers, ovens, etc.) will be accepted as will lawnmowers provided that all fluids have been removed. Tires will also be accepted as long as they have been removed from the rims.

Items containing freon, such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc. will be accepted when accompanied by either a “Certificate of Evacuation” or the pre-payment of a \$15 per unit evacuation fee. Registration and pre-payment for freon evacuation will be accepted weekdays through Friday, April 27, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., at the Delhi Township Administration Building, 934 Neeb Road or the Delhi Township Public Works Department, 665 Neeb Road.
