### Delhi Parks Summer Programs

Delhi Township Parks and Recreation Department is proud to offer their 2007 Summer Programs, sponsored by **Cheviot Savings Bank**, from June 11<sup>th</sup> through August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Various programs will be held throughout the summer including Baby Sitting/CPR and other safety sessions hosted by the Delhi Fire Department and the Delhi Police Department.

Other programs offered again this year include soccer, tennis, basketball, sand volleyball, arts and crafts, wiffle ball, flag football, karate and dance. The **Cincinnati Martial Arts Club** will facilitate the Karate program with a high energy week, while the **Miracle Dance Studio** will teach a variety of dance forms including ballet, tap, jazz, hip-hop and musical theatre. **Anonymous Skateboards** will explain how to ollie, kick flip, skate the hubbas and more during the new skateboarding program.

The cost of participation for most programs is \$7.50 per child per program and participation in each program is limited to Delhi Township residents.
