Delhi Township Public Works Director to Retire

The Delhi Township Board of Trustees announces that Delhi Township Public Works Director Bob Bass will retire on April 30th of this year.

Mr. Bass began his full time career with Delhi Township in 1979 as a service worker and in 1984 moved to the position of Highway Superintendent which later became the position of Public Works Director.

The Public Works department is responsible for maintaining most of the Township-owned facilities and grounds, storm water drainage and the upkeep and repair of most of Delhi's residential streets, including snow and ice removal.

Throughout his career with the Township Mr. Bass has been involved in, and responsible for, several high profile projects designed to benefit the residents of Delhi. In addition to planned projects such as the construction of the Floral Paradise greenhouse, Story Woods and the renovation of the Springhouse, Mr. Bass also was involved in the cleanup of the Glenroy-Schroer and Rapid Run flooding issues and the hurricane-like wind storm of 2008.

Mr. Bass has also attained a variety of grants for the Township. It is estimated that during his career the Township has received grants totaling nearly twenty-five million dollars for various projects such as roadway rehabilitation and reconstruction, Floral Paradise Gardens, the Springhouse restoration, and numerous other projects.
