Fire Department Open House

The Delhi Township Fire Department will host their annual open house on Sunday, October 17th from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Neeb Road Fire Station. Efforts have been made to emphasize more hands on activities designed to enhance the visitor's knowledge and promote personal safety.

At various times throughout the day Delhi Firefighters will instruct visitors on how to properly operate a fire extinguisher using actual fire extinguishers and a training simulator.

Visitors will also be educated on basic medical procedures such as dressing and wrapping wounds, airway control and assisting patients prior to the arrival of paramedics.

Firefighters will educate visitors on how to evacuate a smoke filled building. A trailer, designed for kid's participation and education, will use imitation smoke to decrease visibility and provide a simulation of a smoke filled room.

Parents are encouraged to bring their camera and take pictures of their children as they explore a fire truck or meet Sparky the Dog who will also be on hand.

A representative from Children's hospital will provide advice and answer questions on children's car seats.

Guided tours of the fire station will be provided and the Fire Chief and Assistant Chiefs will also host an open forum.

The Fire Museum, with memorabilia including a 92 year old fire truck, will provide a historical perspective of the 75 years the Delhi Township Fire Department has been providing service to the community.

All are invited to attend this free event. Refreshments will also be available at no cost courtesy of several Delhi Township businesses.

This will be an excellent learning event for the entire family, a good time for the kids and a chance to personally meet your Delhi Township Firefighters who wish to thank the community for their continued support and encourage everyone to attend the open house.
