Clean-Up Delhi Day – April 30, 2011

Delhi Township residents are encouraged to participate in the annual “Clean-Up Delhi Day” to be held on Saturday, April 30th from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. in the parking lot of the Senior Citizens/Community Center at 647 Neeb Road. This event will take place “rain or shine” and is open to Delhi Township residents only. Proof of residency will be required when items are dropped off. Residents must be in line by 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 30th in order to participate in this free event.

No yard waste, computer equipment, hazardous chemicals, paint, liquids, batteries or closed drums will be accepted.

Furniture, garbage, whiteware products (washing machines, dryers, ovens, etc.) will be accepted as will lawnmowers provided that all fluids have been removed. Tires will also be accepted as long as they have been removed from the rims.

Items containing freon, such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc. will be accepted when accompanied by either a “Certificate of Evacuation” or the pre-payment of an \$18 per unit evacuation fee. Registration and pre-payment for freon evacuation will be accepted weekdays through Friday, April 29th from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., at the Delhi Township Administration Building, 934 Neeb Road or from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. at the Delhi Township Public Works Department, 665 Neeb Road.

In conjunction with Clean-Up Delhi Day the Delhi Business Association and the Delhi Civic Association are also sponsoring a paper shredding event on Saturday, April 30th. Delhi Township residents can bring any paper documents they wish to have shredded to the parking lot at C. O. Harrison School on Neeb Road from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and have those documents shredded on site at no charge. This event will also take place “rain or shine” and is also open to Delhi Township residents only. Proof of residency will be required to participate in this event.
