Delhi Township is accepting applications for the position of Police Officer. Delhi Township is an equal opportunities employer.

The preferred candidate is at least 21 years of age, possesses a high school diploma or equivalent, has a valid driver's license, and has a current Peace Officer certification issued by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Council.

This is a full-time position requiring thorough knowledge of criminal law, investigation methods, and crime prevention tactics. Applicants must be able to comprehend and react to oral instructions and possess the physical ability necessary to apprehend suspects.

Upon thorough review of applications, candidates selected to continue on in the process will be required to successfully complete an extensive interview(s) process. Once a candidate is selected, the candidate must successfully complete an in-depth background check and polygraph prior to being given a conditional offer. Upon being selected and given a conditional offer, the candidate must successfully complete a psychological assessment and pass a medical examination. Upon successful completion of the medical and psychological assessments, the candidate may be offered the position.

This position is subject to a Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Delhi Police Association and Delhi Township. The starting salary of an entry level police officer is \$33.68 per hour. However, a candidate with prior law enforcement experience may be hired in at a rate up to \$40.35 per hour.
